#### Afternoon Pick Up Procedures

The school has recognised a small systems problem with the 'Afternoon Pick Up' procedures. We will continue to assemble the children underneath the COLA of the hall and line them up in their appropriate lines for dismissal.

We request that parents keep this area clear and wait for children on the seated concrete area near our pizza oven. This will ensure the COLA is less congested and we can organise the children into their dismissal line more effectively.

Once the second bell has rung, the parents can collect children. We ask that parents wait until this bell to assist with our afternoon routine.

We thank the community for their anticipated co-operation and understanding.

#### **Safety Evacuation Practices**

All schools are mandated by law to practice evacuation drills as part of their WHS (Work Health and Safety) procedures. These drills take the form of either: 1) Evacuation from the classrooms to the oval or basketball courts; 2) Lockdown in classroom and/or 3) Evacuation from Premises to the Golf Club Car park.

Later this term, our school will practice an 'Evacuation from classroom' drill. I am confident that in the unlikely event of an emergency, all children will know our expectations, which will ensure everyone is safe.
